**Democratic Party of Benton County Announces Special Convention to Nominate
Candidate for House District 8 Special Election**

Rogers, AR — The Democratic Party of Benton County (DPBC) will hold a Special Convention on Monday, August 24, bringing together its members to hear nominations for, and vote on, the Democratic candidate who will appear on the November 3rd Special Election ballot. This election, called by the Governor of Arkansas, will determine who will fill the remaining term for the Arkansas House District 8 seat.

The Special Convention will take place at DPBC Headquarters in Rogers, beginning at 6:30 p.m. Members of the Democratic Party of Benton County are eligible to participate in the nomination process and cast their votes. Voting will be conducted in person during the convention, following DPBC rules and procedures for special-called nominating conventions.

This Special Convention ensures that Benton County Democrats have a clear, unified voice in selecting their nominee for this important legislative seat, which will represent the district through the remainder of the current term.
